**RE: CHANGE ON MODALITIES FOR PAYMENT OF MEDICAL CAPITATION FEE
FROM ACADEMIC YEAR 2021/2022**

The Management of Ardhi University wishes to inform the ARU Students Community (including first year 2021/2022) that of recent, NHIF has changed the modalities for payment of NHIF Medical Capitation Fee. Previously, this fee amounting to TShs 50,400/= was paid to the University as part of direct cost. As a result of the change, this fee is will now be paid directly to NHIF. Therefore, the total amount of direct cost paid to the Ardhi University will now be less the NHIF Medical Capitation Fee

With this change, students will now be able to process **on their own** NHIF registration and payment of NHIF fees through ARU - NHIF Online Student Registration Portal (NHIF Student Portal at www.aru.ac.tz). However, this will be preceded by successful completion of registration for studentship at Ardhi University (including payment of the requisite University fees).

After successful registration for studentship, students will be able to login into the ARU-NHIF student Portal using their username and passwords (created during AMIS registration). Once in the NHIF online system, students will request for control numbers which they will use to pay for NHIF fee.
