



CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR THE DAAD IN-COUNTRY/IN-REGION SCHOLARSHIPS PROGRAMME FOR MSC GEOMATICS AT ARDHI UNIVERSITY

Ardhi University in collaboration with the DAAD are happy to announce **up to 2 In-Country and 6 In-Region** scholarships for the **2026 Intake** to pursue MSc Geomatics at Ardhi University. **In-Country** scholarships designed for students who study in their home country or in the country for which they have a residence permit (i.e. Tanzanians) whereas **In-Region** scholarships are designed for students who want to participate in a study programme in a country of their home region (here: Sub-Saharan Africa /outside their home country/in the country for which they do not have a residence permit). Successful applicants are expected to enroll and begin their studies physically at Ardhi University in 2026/2027 academic year.

Duration of the scholarship:

The duration of the Masters programmes (MSc by coursework and dissertation) is 18 months generally starting in November 2026. Students already enrolled in the programmes can also apply for the scholarship to cover the remaining period of their study from November 2026. The Masters scholarships will be awarded for a **maximum of 18 months**. It will be initially granted for one year and may then be extended upon request subject to making satisfactory progress. The scholarship will cover monthly stipend, tuition fees, study and research allowance, thesis publication costs, health insurance and one return ticket for in-region applicants. Information on the finances provided by the scholarship is specified in the DAAD Information Sheet for Scholars attached to this call.

Equal opportunities: Female candidates and candidates from less privileged regions or groups as well as candidates with disabilities are encouraged to apply.

Application Requirements:

In line with DAAD regulations applicants have to fulfil the following formal requirements:





- a) The last university degree must have been completed **less than six years** at the time of application.
- b) Citizenship of a country in Sub-Saharan Africa.
- c) Bachelor's degree qualification with at least above average results.
- d) Staff member of a public or private university OR candidates that can be considered for teaching in a university or research positions

Application Procedure and Deadline:

1. Copies of all application documents for the **scholarship** specified in the attached DAAD Call for Master Scholarship Applications 2026 at Ardhi University must be submitted **via the DAAD portal by 27th November 2025**. The call is also available at:

Simultaneously, applicants are required to apply for **admission** by filling in the Postgraduate Application form attached to this call and available from Ardhi University's website and submit it together with all supporting documents and a motivation letter to **Ardhi University by 23rd January 2026**.
