



Advertisement for DAAD In-Country/In-Region Postgraduate Scholarship Programme

DAAD in collaboration with Ardhi University are happy to announce that it is in a position to offer up to **2 In-Country and 6 In-region scholarships for the 2013 intake** to pursue MSc Geomatics

Duration of the scholarship:

The duration of the Masters programmes (MSc by coursework and dissertation) is 18 months generally starting in November 2023. Students already enrolled in the programme can also apply for scholarship for the remaining period. The Masters scholarships will be awarded for a maximum of 18 months. It will be initially granted for one year and may then be extended upon request subject to making satisfactory progress. The scholarship benefits are as stipulated by DAAD and will generally cover tuition fees, a monthly stipend, research funds and a return ticket for in-region students.

Equal opportunities: Female candidates and candidates and those from less privileged regions or groups as well as candidates with disabilities are encouraged to apply.

Application Requirements:

In line with DAAD regulations applicants have to fulfil the following formal requirements:

- a) Hold a bachelor's degree qualification with at least above average results.
- b) The bachelor's university degree must have been completed less than six years ago at the time of application.
- c) Show clear motivation and commitment
- d) Exhibit thorough knowledge of English as a language of instruction
- e) Be a national or permanent resident of a country in Sub-Saharan Africa.
- f) Be a staff member of a public university or one that can be considered for recruitment to a teaching or research positions in a university, or a staff member from the public sector and/or alumni of the DAFI-programme.

Application Procedure and Deadline:

Copies of all application documents specified in the attached DAAD Call for Scholarship Applications 2023 must be submitted via the DAAD portal by **9th December 2022**, except for the Letter of admission from the host University. Simultaneously, to facilitate issuing of the letter of admission, applicants are required to fill in the Postgraduate Application forms which are available on Ardhi University's website: <https://www.aru.ac.tz/uploads/documents/en-1624627895-Postgraduate%20Application%20Forms.pdf>. The forms should be submitted together with all supporting documents to Ardhi University. All submissions should be addressed to the following address:
